Impact of Geographical Indication Labeling on Consumer Buying Behavior With Special Reference to Selected Districts In Kerala

Geographical Indication (GI) serves as a distinctive marker that indicates the origin of a particular product from a specific geographical area. It signifies that the product possesses certain qualities, reputation, or other distinctive characteristics that can be primarily attributed to its geographical origin. Therefore, the primary purpose of a geographical indication (GI) is to establish a correlation between the specific attributes, qualities, or reputation of a product and its geographical origin. Geographical indications (GIs) are primarily employed for agricultural and food commodities, which commonly exhibit a strong inherent association with their specific geographical location. The origins of geographical indication (GI) protection in India can be traced back to the early 20th century. The Madras Chamber of Commerce and Industry put forth the initial proposal for the protection of geographical indications in India in 1905. There has been a suggestion to grant legal protection to specific regions in order to safeguard the distinctive characteristics of their products. Nevertheless, the enactment of the Geographical Indications of Goods (Registration and Protection) Act by the Indian government occurred in 1999.

This study holds substantial legal and economic importance as it investigates the various factors that influence consumer behaviour towards Geographical Indication (GI) Products, thereby contributing to their developmental support. This study provides academics with the opportunity to conduct an analysis in the field of Geographical indications. The majority of research studies on the contribution of Geographical indications to development have been conducted in the European Union (EU) and various developing countries.

The research findings underscore the necessity for both producers and policymakers to acknowledge these influencing factors and tailor their strategies accordingly. For producers, this means investing in quality control, branding, and marketing efforts to convey the authenticity and unique characteristics of their GI products. Policymakers, on the other hand, must establish regulatory frameworks and protection mechanisms that safeguard the integrity of geographical indications while promoting consumer awareness and trust.

As the global marketplace continues to evolve and consumers become more discerning, the factors explored in this thesis will remain vital considerations for those involved in the production and marketing of GI products. This study contributes to a deeper understanding of consumer behavior within this specific context and provides a foundation for further research and practical applications that can drive the success of geographical indication products in an ever-changing world of commerce. In essence, the consumer behavior surrounding GI products is a dynamic and intricate field that demands ongoing attention and adaptation by all stakeholders involved.

This study points to the need for independent evaluation of each GI, based on the consumer behaviour. Though there are different sets of norms already existing in the process of GI registration, the present addition will make registration of GI a more credible tool for marketing the products in a better level. Even if the GI registration is aiming at the protection of name, the basic flow of consumer perception moves in a different way. This research identifies certain factors like ethnocentric (GI) values, product uniqueness values, price value, reputation value as influencing consumer purchase decision and prepares an index for its evaluation. The questionnaire so developed, can be used for further research work in other marketing studies on GI, such as Digitalisation of Marketing of GI products, Adoption of Block Chain Technology in GI Tagged Products, Application of AI In the promotion of GI Tagged Products.


