
Academic Year Evaluation, 2023-2024



IN MEMORY OF ALAN SHIMMY

(II HM CS - 2022-2025; passed away on 25th April 2024)



The dawn of 25th April 2024 was really shocking for many of us because of the saddest news about the unexpected death of our beloved student, Alan Shimmy, who had gone to Chalakudy Railway Station to drop his friend for Bangalore. Alan Shimmy was a second year student of B. Sc Hotel Management Catering Service of the Department of Hotel Management at YIMS. His bike collided with a long route bus at Mannur near Moovattupuzha that brought him to his last breath.

In the book of Jeremiah of the Holy Bible, Chapter 31, verse 15 we read, "A voice is heard in Ramah, mourning and great weeping, Rachel weeping for her children and refusing to be comforted because they are no more". This is what comes to my mind when I stand beside the dead body of Alan because his parents, Cyriac and Manu lost their first son, Shibin about 6 years back. Then onwards, the religious parents committed for their children, bestowed all their hope and aspiration upon Alan who is also no more now. Alan was born on 6th December 2003 and it would be very painful for all of us to bid him eternal farewell at the age of twenty. He took admission at Yuvakshetra Institute of Management Studies, as per the Admission register of the College, on 30th August 2022. Within a very short span of time of twenty months, he earned the hearts of many at YIMS.

The testimonies of the people who knew him reveal the depth of Alan's personality and influencing ability. On hearing the sad demise of Alan, our Principal Dr. Tomy Antony messaged, "Bright and well liked student who would be dearly missed by his classmates, faculties and all who knew him". Jojo Kulapuram, one of his closest friends, was deeply saddened saying that he had been a symbol of silent innocence. Mr. Johnson, his uncle said, Alan was really careful about initiating and maintaining very good friendships, even that nature itself cause his death". Mr. Aneesh CU, his class mentor unbelieving his demise exclaimed, "Silent but brilliant, punctual and smart that merited him two international exposures of World Defense Show in Saudi Arabia held from 4-8 February 2024, and The FIFA World Cup Qatar 2022". Ms. Asha Krishnan, Alan.s English Language Teacher mentioned sadly, "Alan was very good at academics, Excellent scoring in the examinations, well disciplined in behaviour, and master planning in presentations".

Dear Mr. Cyriac and Mrs. Manju, dear relatives and friends, as we are standing beside the dead body of Alan Shimmy, we have no words to comfort you but God can. Let God be your comfort and solace. We express our nearness and condolences. May Alan's Soul Rest In Peace.






