

CURRICULUM FEEDBACK FROM STUDENTS- 2019-20

INTRODUCTION

Feedback is an essential element of the teaching learning process. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the College has continuously been working on quality improvement and the betterment of student learning experiences. In order to analyze the lag areas of the college and scope for further improvement, feedback from various stakeholders have been received. This report focuses on the feedback of students on Syllabus and Teachers.

STUDENTS' FEEDBACK

The Feedback on curriculum was obtained from 1182 students for the Academic year 2019-20. Most of the students were satisfied with the various aspects of teaching like coverage of syllabus in class, the internal evaluation system, the availability of library resources, the relevance and application of the syllabus in real life situations, the general atmosphere of study in the institution etc. Majority of the students shared satisfactory remarks on the relevance and application of the syllabus in real life situation. 71% students responded that reading materials and reference books regarding subjects were easily availed in the college library.76% students commented that the subjects were relevant to job and future aspirations thus indicating that the curriculum provides larger scope for employability. 84% students were satisfied with the overall atmosphere of study in the institution.

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
