5-Day National Webinar



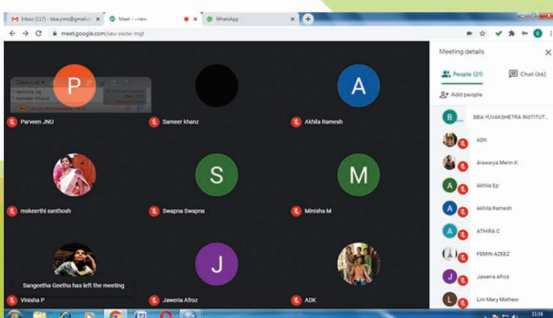
