# The major events of the academic year 2021-22 is given below


## STATE WEBINAR-'AWARENESS ON WOMEN LAWS:

A State Webinar on'Awareness of Women Laws' was organised by the Women Cell & IQAC, of Yuvakshetra Institute of Management Studies in association with Kerala Women Commission. The event was conducted as an interactive session via the Zoom platform on 13 September 2021. The guest of honour for this event was Adv. Shiji Shivaji, member Kerala Women'sCommission and the Guest speaker was Adv: K R Sumesh, Chairman, Development StandingCommittee Koratty Grama Panchayat, Thrissur. The welcome speech was delivered by Ms. Sreeja T.S Asst. Professor Dept. of Mathematics, Women Cell Coordinator Yuvakshetra College, followed by the Presidential address by Rev. Dr Mathew George Vazhayil, Director, YIMS.

The chief guest Adv. Shiji Shivaji inaugurated the session with her boosting words, pointing outthe present scenario around the state. This inspired and encouraged the women students to keepexcelling and consistently moving in life. The whole event was informative which incorporated the law points and its boons and banes. The Guest speaker, Adv: K R Sumesh mesmerized theaudience with his words of wisdom. He addressed on the issues of Dowry-related violence, domestic violence, child abuse and eve-teasing and law points associated with it. He also added that "Women, especially the younger ones, should be legally empowered to tackle those forms of discrimination. Our justice system provides for women's safety and security." More than 500 (Five Hundred) students participated in the event and submitted their response through the feedback link provided during the programme.
















# A SEMINAR ON PREMARITAL COUNSELLING CONDUCTED BY: KERALA WOMEN'S COMMISSION :

The Women Cell of Yuvakshetra Institute of Management Studies organised a Premarital Counselling Seminar in association with the Kerala State Women's Commission on 10th March 2022. The seminar commenced at 1.30 pm at Training Centre Ms. Sreeja T.S., Women's Cell Coordinator, YIMS welcomed everyone. The Presidential Address was delivered by **Rev. Dr Mathew George Vazhayil, Director of Yuvakshetra College. The session was inaugurated by the chief guest Dr. (Prof.) Regunath Parackal, Consutant-Councelling Psychology, Palakkad which was followed by the seminar session. He threw light to the importance of 'Patience' in a married life. He also pointed out the significance in the act of a wife acknowledging her husband through various examples. He spoke on the relevance of the above topic in the present scenario wherein, the divorce cases are rising rapidly. He discussed on the need of having a control over our emotions, especially 'anger'. 
### **DEPARTMENT OF COMPUTER SCIENCE:**


## **PG DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH:**
